



TOUR INCLUDES

- Maryland State House The oldest state capitol building in the nation in continuous use, it was here that George Washington resigned his commission as Commander-in Chief of the Continental Armies to become the President of the United States.
- ✓ St. John's College Walk in the footsteps of the Revolutionary Patriots who met here to plan the overthrow of the English rule. Chartered in 1784, St. John's is the third oldest college in the country.
- ✓ City Dock This is the spot where Kunta Kinte arrived in America, as chronicled by Alex Haley in Roots.
- ✓ United States Naval Academy (photo ID required). The academy, established in 1845, covers more than 300 acres on the south side of the Severn River. Beneath the Academy Chapel you can visit the crypt housing the bronze and marble sarcophagus of John Paul Jones (subject to closure), naval hero of the American Revolution.
